Matters Arising

There are two teams, Shrivenham CC and Westbury CC, who could potentially apply for membership of the CCL by winning Div. 1 of the OCA Premier Division. The Ground & Facilities sub-committee are aware and will carry out initial inspections.

Correspondence

A letter had been received from the OCB Welfare Officer emphasising the ECB Safe Hand Policy regarding juniors playing in adult cricket. The CCL support this policy.

The HCPL are currently discussing expanding their divisions to twelve teams. The CCL have informed the HCPL that the scheme cannot be supported as several clubs already have difficulty obtaining use of grounds in early September.

Finance

Net funds stand at £34544.70 taking into account known assets with £400.0 of invoices outstanding.

Discipline

There have been three recent disciplinary incidents reported and after investigation it is expected that a disciplinary hearing will be held within the next month.

The reports concern incidents in the following matches.

Buckingham Town v Leighton Buzzard – 8^{th} June Wolverton Town v OBNCC – 6^{th} July Gt Brickhill 2 v Thame 2 – 20th July As a result of the umpire reports for the Buckingham v Leighton Buzzard game and a team mark of 3 for BTCC, plus the reporting of a BTCC player for aggressive behaviour towards an opponent. The following suspended penalties issued in 2012 were implemented.

Buckingham Town CC – Deducted 30 points. BTCC player – Suspended for 4 matches.

A Discipline Hearing will be arranged by the Chairman to investigate incidents in the above game.

<u>Results</u>

Registration forms and captain's umpire forms are also not being submitted within the given period.
