## **Matters Arising**

The Umpires' Meeting scheduled in the February minutes for 1<sup>st</sup> May has been changed to 28<sup>th</sup> April at the same venue. Tony Lord has circulated details to umpires but clubs are requested to ensure that as many club umpires as possible attend the meeting.

## Correspondence

The date of the HCPL Link Meeting has had a number of changes. CR will discuss options with the HCPL Chairman.

Abingdon Vale had made several requests regarding the condition of their grounds caused by recent flooding. CR will compile a response.

#### Finance

There was £35,748.65 in the main account and £938.33 in the business reserve account.

The Treasure reported that Cumnor CC had yet to pay their affiliation fee and therefore would be subject to a penalty as per the R&R of the CCL.

The stumps for clubs project is nearing completion and will be ready for distribution at the Captains' meeting on 24<sup>th</sup> April.

A request had been sent out to clubs requesting the amount of balls required for the 2014 season.

LP gave a resume of the insurance cover for CCL Officers for the 2014 season.

# HCPL/TVL

CR, SB & RG met with representatives of the Thames Valley League and several issues were discussed. Further discussions will be held during the season with ECB involvement.

#### **Registration Fees**

It was agreed, because of the CCL's present financial position that registration fees would be reduced with a £2 fee prior to the start of the 2014 season and £7.00 for registrations during the season.

#### **New Regulations**

Maximum third of overs rule – It will be the Captain's responsibility to ensure that no player bowls more than a third of the overs **AVAILABLE AT THE START OF THE INNINGS.** The game will normally be forfeited if this rule is broken.

The regulations covering players dropping down from higher leagues and playing in the CCL will be put into the 2014 handbook. The wording will be compiled by CR & GM.

## **Captains' Meeting**

Will, as already distributed, be held on 24<sup>th</sup> April 2014 at BNOCC. All clubs are reminded that the Captains of each of their teams **must** attend the meeting. They will also be responsible for collecting their Club's balls, handbooks and stumps on the evening. Balls must be paid for prior to the meeting or, at the very latest, at the meeting.
