

## **It's Your Call – Cricket Umpire Education 2022 in Buckinghamshire**

### **Introduction**

The mantra from the ECB is education for all. This means that whether you are interested in becoming a cricket umpire at a recreational level or for a league, still play cricket and want to know more about the laws or are just interested in learning more about the laws of cricket and how they are implemented, then Bucks ACO have courses for you! Courses are open to all ages.

### **Stage One**

This is designed to give an overview of the basic Laws of the game and how to apply them and introduce the principles of field craft and match management. It gives the tools to enable a person to umpire matches at the basic recreational level where no independent umpires are appointed.

We have organised one face to face stage one course for early 2022, which takes place on two successive Saturdays. Details of these courses are as follows:

### **Stage Two**

This course is designed to give participants further knowledge and skills to enable them to become members of league panels and is available to anyone who has attended Stage One or equivalent online. This course complements the Stage One by looking beyond the basic laws, builds on field craft and match management techniques and introduces the concept of working, as a team, with a colleague.

It is intended that participants can either take this immediately after completing the Stage One or wait until the next training season. However a discount will be given if this is a direct follow on course from Stage One.
